Dress code for Boys: dress pants, dress shirt, and tie are required; blazer is encouraged. Shirt must be tucked into pants. No jeans. No sneakers.

Dress Code for Girls: dress or skirt with blouse. No pants. No sneakers. (However please wear shoes comfortable for dancing – we recommend flats and avoiding high heels.)
