New! PTA Needs Your Continuous Support

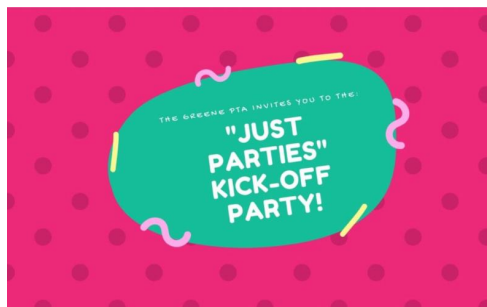
